Outdoor Education Advisory Working Group Report to the Nevada State Legislature

SUMMARY

BILL RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Establish a sustained network to support and recognize school and teacher efforts in outdoor education.
- 2. Establish a new position with the Department of Education dedicated to supporting outdoor education and integration into all curriculum areas.
- 3. Increase funding for the Nevada Outdoor Education and Recreation Grant program to a minimum of \$500,000 per fiscal year to ensure dedicated support for outdoor education initiatives statewide.



CAPACITY BUILDING

- Establish outdoor education specialists at each school, or utilize existing specialists
- Analyze and share current resources
- Collaborate across state agencies to pursue joint funding opportunities



CONTENT INTEGRATION

- Develop interdisciplinary placebased lessons
- Use outdoor education to develop critical skills
- Identify regionally relevant outdoor experiences
- Develop outdoor electives
- Take learning outside
- Support field trips



OUTDOOR LEARNING INFRASTRUCTURE

- Create living schoolyards
- Involve students and families \
 in schoolyard design
- Consider climate resilient design and shade
- Prioritize schoolground nature exposure
